The Region of Southern Denmark expects to employ further foreign GP's in 2016 or 2017 in our special 14 month trial/introductory positions. Within this position you will get a 6 month intensive language course and time mentoring a Tutor Practice to "retraining" to "become a Danish GP" and professional relevant training. You will receive a attractive salary from your first day in the language course in Denmark.

It is important that you enclose a motivated application, your CV and any documentation from your specialisation (in English language). We are looking for candidates who are the best qualified according to the Danish GP system, doctors who have some experience as an independent GP and who have the potential to learn the language in a short period of time.

The employment:

The position is a 14-month evaluation/introduction residency with a working week of 37 hours.

The gross salary is DKK 48,722.80 per month (before tax). From this salary, 5.17% (= DKK 2,518.97) will be placed in a pension scheme with the Physicians' Pension Fund. The employer pays an additional amount to the pension fund corresponding to 10.33% of the salary. On the salary, 12.95% holiday allowance is earned that can be paid out to you later. Average income for a Danish GP per year: Practice/clinic turnover approx. DKK 1.7 million. **227.000 euros per year before tax.**
